Roy Bloom CJF APF has been shoeing horses since 1973. He has been a member of the American Farrier's Team on two different occasions and for many years served as the manager of the team.

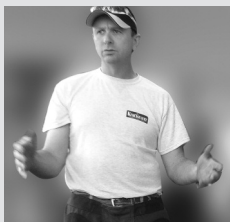

Conrad Trow, CJF DipWCF

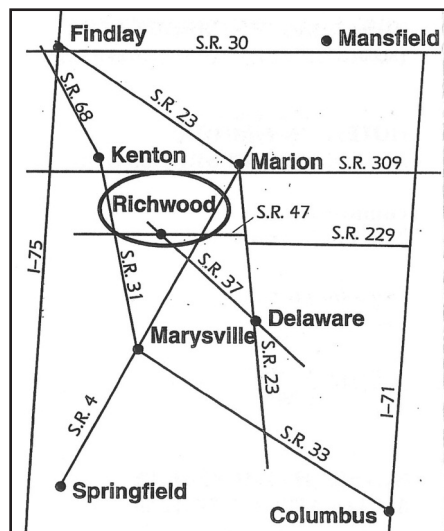

After some years at home, Conrad returned to the KHS in 1999 to apprentice under Mitch Taylor. Conrad has since established himself among the best of the best in horseshoeing in the United States. Along with his successful private farrier business, Conrad has been a member of the American Farriers Association National Horseshoeing Team, where he has won gold both nationally and internationally in horseshoeing competitions. Conrad was also a member of the 2007 American Farriers Association 4-man World Stampede in Canada. In addition, he was part of the 2-Man Draft Horse Championship team which won at the AFA Convention in 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006. He also holds a diploma with The Worshipful Company of Farriers.

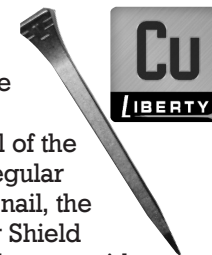
