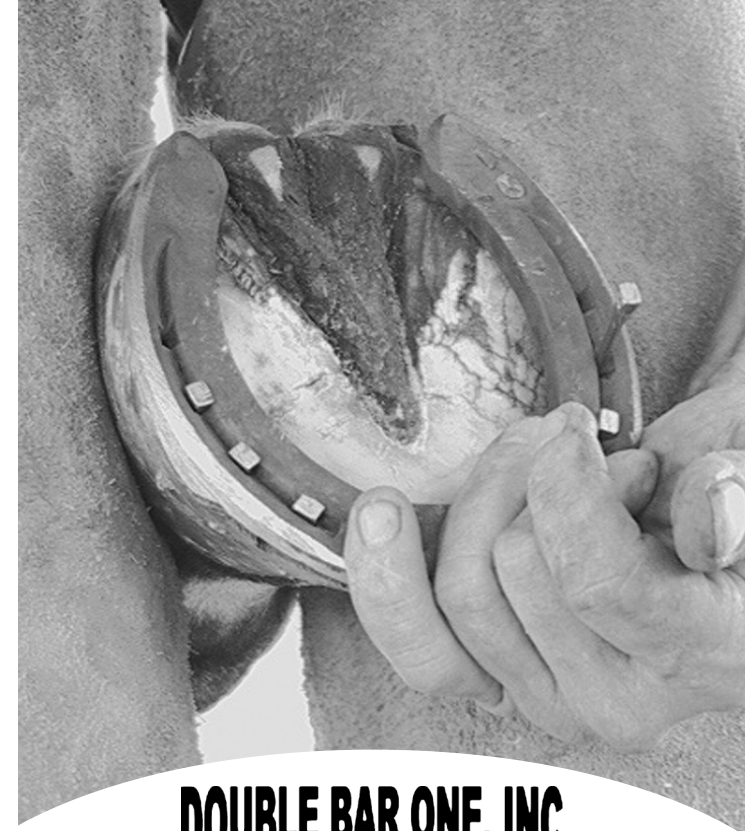

Travis Burns is an Assistant Professor of Practice in the department of Large Animal Clinical Sciences at the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine at Virginia Tech. Travis is a Certified Journeyman Farrier (CJF) with Therapeutic (TE) and Educator Endorsements (EE) from the American Farrier's Association. He is also one of six Americans to become a Fellow in the Worshipful Company of Farriers (by examination) from the United Kingdom (FWCF). He currently serves as the Chief of Farrier Services in the Equine Podiatry Service of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital.



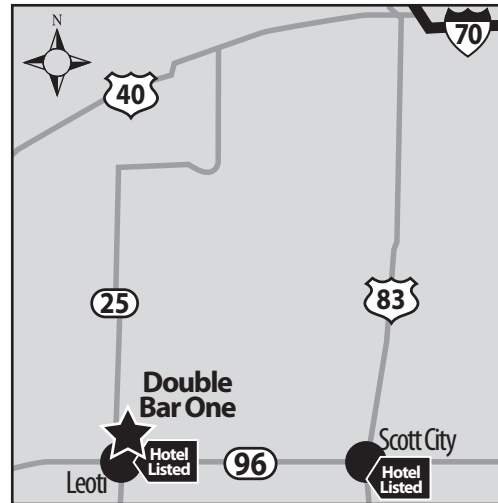
He attended farrier school at the North Carolina School of Horseshoeing and received a bachelor's degree in animal science from North Carolina State University. Burns worked at North Carolina State University College of Veterinary Medicine before entering into a one-year internship program at Forging Ahead, an elite multi-farrier practice in Northern Virginia. Upon completion of the internship program, he was retained at Forging Ahead as an associate farrier until joining the college in 2010.

Since becoming a faculty member at the VMCVM he has given more than 130 presentations to professional and lay groups nationally and internationally. His clinical and research interests include laminar morphology and hoof crack repair materials.
